Business Meeting notes

Officer Reports

Exchequer – The Barony currently has \$3845. This is down \$350 from last month's meeting. Current expenses are the Fight Practice rental fees and some final expenses from Winter's End. The report for Winter's end is complete, the Barony made a profit of \$568 from the event.

Seneschal – Preparations for May Day continue

Heavy Marshal – There are new fighters in the Barony

Rapier Marshal – New fighters have authorized. Inactive rapier fighters will be removed from the roster as of next month.

Archery Marshal – Archery MITs will be needed to help run the range at May Day. The Archery Marshal will be stepping down and a replacement is needed. Archery MITs are eligible for the office

MOAS – Progress continues on the Queen's Favors for Pennsic . An armor-making day is being planned; many hands are needed to turn molded plastic components into usable armor. It is possible that the B&G club will be the venue for the armor-making day. THL Reinhold planning to continue to make plastic armor for the Barony, possibly setting up the Barony to make armor for fundraising.

Chatelaine – We continue to have new people coming to the Barony

Webmistress – The website has been updated with information for May Day

Youth Minister – Help is needed for Youth Activities during May Day

Old Business

May Day – Site setup will occur on Friday Night. Archery has been approved, there will be 8 bales for targets. Camping is permitted near the shelter on Saturday night. The park is charging a fee of \$25 per tent. At present ONE team has registered for the Dragon Chef Challenge. There will be 2 or 3 children's activities lasting approximately 1 hour each. A signup sheet for event volunteers will be posted online. The event schedule is being finalized.

Return of the Hunt for the Rogue October – After a brief review of the bid, the event was approved. 13 votes For, 0 Against, 2 Abstentions

Queen's Favor Project – So far, 2 completed favors have been submitted. There are signs of progress. A workshop is planned for A&S night

SCA Demo in Milford – Scheduled for June 13, Confirmations sheets are needed by the library. A thread on the demo will be put up on Facebook. A marshal is needed to allow combat demonstrations at the Demo.

New Business

Goettafest Fundraiser – Goettafest will occur August 6-10. The Barony is again invited to run a game booth. Ideas are welcomed for a more medieval themed game; if the Barony does to supply its own, a game will be provided. The location of the SCA's booth has not been determined.

Baronial Championships – Championships will occur on Labor Day weekend. Bids need to be submitted for this event. Some possible sites were suggested, including AJ Jolly, Camp Ernst, and the Boy Scout Camp.
