

We would also like to welcome you to attend us at our Twelfth Night in Fenix. The Vicar of the Church of Grace in our City of Florence has graciously offered use of the chapel for this year's Twelfth Night and Court. Please help us adorn our hall with festive decorations and personal heraldry. Their Majesties are aware that there are those among our populace deserving of recognition, and we are pleased to have been asked to bestow awards on Their behalf. For Bardic:

We are placing no particular restrictions on the form or subject matter of your bardic entries. These will be heard in the chapel in the afternoon. In the event of your selection as our Champion, please be prepared to present your bardic entry at dinner, with perhaps an additional selection for the entertainment of all.

For Games:

Our resident games expert, the Honorable Lady Elspeth Clerk, has graciously offered to run the Games Championship. The championship will be in three parts: a board game, a dice game, and a card game.

The board game portion will be played in a round robin tournament style. Challengers earn one point for each win.

The dice game will be played by all challengers at the same time, for a set number of rounds (based on the number of challengers) with a score given at the end of each round. At the end of the rounds, challengers earn the total of their scores.

The card game will be played for a set number of rounds, with each challenger starting with the same number of tokens. At the end of the rounds, challengers earn a score based on the number of tokens they have.

The specific games have been chosen and will be revealed at Twelfth Night.

Senior Pages' Display at Craftsperson's Faire


