Seneschal – Planning progresses on May Day. Signed off on the Domesday from the Exchequer the other day.

May Day –

- Motion for misc. budget of \$50, to include potential purchase of hand sanitizer for latrines by camping and archery. Seconded and passed.
- Volunteers needed for retainers, guards, and front gate.
- Advance of \$200 for lunch. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
- Rachel of Stahlgeist will be heading up at Youth Pointe. Yay! If you would like to teach a youth class or donate items for youth activities, please contact her.
- Serving lunch for 100. Lunch will include meatballs. There will also be a vegan and gluten free option. \$5 per lunch, as well as \$1 a la carte items.
- Staff can start arriving at noon on Friday of May Day. The event itself starts at 6pm.
- Need ropes and rebar for parking.
- Need someone to make signs for Troll, royalty parking, staff hall, and royal hall.
- Need lighting donations to light the pathway from camping to the program building for night time.
- Request for donations of fighter snacks.
- Need list poles and ropes for the event, as well as a pop-up tent for youth combat.
