

## June 2019 Meeting Notes

### **Officer Reports:**

Baronets –

- Pennsic Planning cookout is on Sunday June 30<sup>th</sup> at Delhi Park, Shelter #2. We will start around 1-2pm with an informal fight practice as well as socializing and crafting. Cookout after. We will bring charcoal and some sides. Bring what you want to grill and something to share. Want to discuss the nuts and bolts of the Pennsic camp. Since that is after the pre-reg deadline, we should have a good idea of how many folks will be camping with the Barony.
- Pennsic is coming. Have some additional tabards and capes for those who want to fight with the Barony. Also planning to take a group up to the archery range to shoot the war points together. Day to be determined, once the full schedule is posted.
- Simple Day. We are starting some Shenanigans at Simple Day with Sternfeld and Flame. Come if you can.
- Needing replacements for Baronial officers. Please consider taking a job. Lots of folks to help and guide.
- Tri-Baronial 12<sup>th</sup> Night. This year is the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Flaming Gryphon and they have invited us and Middle Marches to do a joint tri-baronial 12<sup>th</sup> Night. We can still do our own small local one, but would like to celebrate the baronies from which we came.
- Baronial Championships. Zelemir and Gertrude (Josh and Marie Hamaker) have volunteered their 3 acre property for Baronial Championships. Will go through a bid process, but the only expense would be renting a port-a-john. We can do all of the championships there.
- Group projects going forward that we would like to discuss – carrying bags for the thrones, favors for members to wear when shooting archery, thrown weapons, etc. to show our baronial pride.
