

Letter from the Baron and Baroness

Unto the noble populace of Fenix, Greetings!

The mix in our Fenix Baronial camp is a little different each year, and we value all of you whom we get to spend time with.

Letter from the Herald

So, you want to be a herald...

No doubt you've gone to events and been to court. If you haven't you soon will! The people who boisterously and enthusiastically announce things during events and during court are usually heralds! But that's not the only thing heralds do. In fact, there are a couple different kinds of heralds. List Herald, Court Herald and Consulting heralds!

A list herald is the herald whom; during tournaments and chivalric fighting exercises will announce that someone is taking the field; or summon a fighter to the field.

A Court Herald is someone who announces the entry of the sitting body of authority; guests and nobility. They summon people to receive awards for scrolls and aid the royal body in holding the necessary script for certain ceremonies.

The Court Herald is often aided by the Signet. The Signet is the one who holds the scrolls and carries the awards. Making sure that the herald has the right scroll for the award they are supposed to be announcing at that time.

The Consulting Herald are the ones that sit with you and talk to you about your persona; help you register your name and come up with a personal device that fits the period and place you're working in.

Here in the barony we have a Baronial Pursuivant. [That's Me!] At the moment, I am aided by many wonderful friends to attempt to fulfill all of your heraldic needs, but many have expressed interest in getting into heraldry on their own. I am addressing in this letter the first basics you're going to want to handle.

First. Voice Heraldry can be intimidating to start off. If you're not used to speaking loudly the idea of doing it in front of a hundred people can cause some stage fright. That's okay. The way I got over it [And maybe it will help you too.] Is to go to a fight practice and try to talk to someone over the din of fighters in the gym that we hold practice in sometimes. It's turns out not to be too easy, but you learn volume without shouting!

Second. Read the Pursuivant's handbook! <http://www.midrealm.org/heraldry/>

In this link there are a ton of documents. I would recommend to eventually glance or read through them all. It will cover a lot of design points; teach you what Midrealm expects of its heralds and all the other lovely things.

Going forwards through newsletters and events I will be breaking down some of the articles covered on the various Midrealm and SCA heralding Facebook pages and some of the documents provided in the link above.

Letter from the Exchequer

Greetings,

We are doing well on the financial front, currently with \$5,274.05 in the bank.

Baronial Champions was pretty well attended. While probably not absolutely everyone signed in, we had 31 who did.

Recently, we were notified that Kentucky will be requiring us to collect Sales Tax at Events which charge admission. The specific rules regarding that are copied from the "State by State SCA Sales Tax Procedures" document I received in the notification are below:

Policy for Collecting Sales Tax in Kentucky at Events

1. Events held in Kentucky by any group will need to collect sales tax on admissions.
2. The amount of tax to be collected is 6%.
3. Kingdoms will provide a list of all events that will be held in Kentucky on a regular basis to the Corporate Office at taxes@sca.org. This includes local events that collect registration, feast fees, etc. that may not be listed on the kingdom calendar. For each event, the group's seneschal or exchequer contact information must be included. This is to allow the corporate office to send the required form to the group, prior to any fees being collected.
4. Groups do not need to collect sales tax on "donation only" events.
5. Groups may include the sales tax as part of the price but must provide that information on their flyers and at the door stating that tax is included in the price. Otherwise they will need to calculate the sales tax on each transaction.
6. At the end of the event, the local exchequer will fill out the required form and within ten (10) business days from the end of the event, mail the check and the form to the Corporate Office address listed.
7. A copy of the same report shall be emailed to the kingdom exchequer and taxes@sca.org.
8. In the case of an emergency delay in submitting, written notification must be sent to the Corporate Office. This notice must include all contact information, reason for the delay, and the guaranteed date of submission (not to exceed 30 days from the date of the event).
9. Failure to comply with the outlined procedures will result in the Kingdom being placed in Abeyance.
