# Letter from the Rapier Marshal

Greetings Fencers of Fenix!

This has been a very exciting quarter, good and bad, with most of that excitement condensed within the past few weeks. So let's start this letter off with a safety and rules reminder:

## DO NOT JUMP DURING A FIGHT!

Don't do it. Ever. You should never perform an action on the list that you cannot safely and immediately pause should a hold be called. If you are in mid air, you cannot stop yourself from falling. If you make an attack while airborne, you run a massive risk of injuring your opponent. Don't do it. If you jump towards your opponent, you run the risk of landing on their weapon, which could cause severe injury to yourself. Don't do it.

That out of the way, we have had a LOT of new fighters! Practices are busy and bustling with teaching and learning. However, we have come across a hole in our loaner kit!. While we have multiple helmets of varying sizes and under or over hoods for all of them, we are lacking in coats. We have 4 or so coats ranging in size between Medium and Large, and while a small body can wear a coat too large, a large body cannot wear a coat too small. We are in need of at least one XXL or XXXL sized fencing coat to close that gap and make sure that all new and visiting fencers who are in need have the opportunity to try their hand at Rapier.

For our veteran fencers, while news of the armor experiment has spread rapidly, I want to bring attention to it here. The Middle Kingdom is currently conducting a reduced armor experiment for Rapier fighting, and only a few weeks in it is wildly popular and widely used.
